

DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING
OVERCALLS (Style; Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)
1 level could be weak, 2 level 10+ and good suit
Over 1c, 2d= majors
INT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
Direct - strong NT – System on – Note 12
5/5 in other suits from passed hand – Note 12
Protective seat 10-14 – system on
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
2nt shows lower 2 suits
3c higher suits
Otherwise all jumps pre-emptive
Reopen: stronger weak 2 to play
DIRECT & JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)
Direct cue-extreme suits
Jump cue splinter as responder
VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening;PH)
Strong Nt – Hamilton with dbl showing longer minor and 4 cd major
Weak Nt – Hamilton and dbl = Pen
VS.PREEMTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)
X = t/o. Leaping and non-leaping Michaels
Nt strong to play
Cue bid = strong t/o
VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♣ or 2♣
System on after strong openings
OVER OPPONENTS' TAKEOUT DOUBLE
Jumps are weak
2NT agrees major, Invitational or better
