- 1. M: 2N = slam try show shortage then 1st and 2nd round controls (Jacoby 2NT)
- 2. 1 ♦: 2N= slam try show shortage then 1st and 2nd round controls (Jacoby 2NT)
- 3. Defence against NT = DON'T suit bid + 1 higher 4/5 or 5/4, response1 suit higher than suit bid show your 2^{nd} suit
- 4. Defence to Ghestem (weak max 14 high card points)
- 5. Defence against Multi 2 ♦: double = 12/14 or 18+ 2NT = 15/17
- 6. Trial bids after suit agreement
