

DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING
OVERCALLS (Style; Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)
overcall: 9–17 HCP, NS F1, CB 10+ 3c support, 2N raise over M
JS is fit-showing, jump cue splinter
cue bid: Michaels – 2N asks minor
3 of their suit: stopper ask for 3N
leaping and non-leaping Michaels over pre-empt
2N: 2 lowest unbid, but in protective seat 18–20 balanced
1NT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
2 nd : 15–18, system on
4 th : 11–14, system on; may not have stopper
Sandwich: 17–19, system on
Reopening: 17–19, system on
Transfer into their suit is takeout
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
Fairly standard weak jump overcalls.
After 2-level WJO, 2N is Vinny.
Opener strives to reopen when short in their suit.
DIRECT & JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)
2-level CB: Michaels, ≤6 losers
3-level CB: stopper ask, usually running minor
J-2N overcall: unusual, but natural in protective seat
v. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening; PH)
X is 5m+4M or either minor v. strong, penalty v. weak
Other bids are Multi-Landy style: 2♣ majors, 2♦ either major
2♥ hearts + minor, 2♠ spades + minor, 2N minors
After an overcall, 2N by advancer asks for shape and strength
v. PREEMTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)
2N ±16–18, system on; 4N 2-places to play
3N (over 3X): to play. Gladiator continuations.
X always t/o
cue bid: 3-level = stopper ask; 4-level = Michaels
4m = leaping or non-leaping Michaels
v. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♣
X ♠♥, 1N ♦♣, 1♦, 1♥, 1♠, 2♣ suit and touching higher
Same after 1♣–1♦ negative: X ♦+♠, 1N ♠+♥
OVER OPPONENTS' TAKEOUT DOUBLE
1M–[X]: BROMAD – 2♣, 2♦, 3♣, 3♦ all raises, 2N = long minor
1m–[X]: 2N unbal. LR+, F1; JS weak; XX is F-2N (unless pulled)

SPECIAL, ARTIFICIAL & COMPETITIVE DBLS/RDLS			
Double of a p/c bid is for takeout			
Double of a UCB shows that bid if we in auction, A or K if not in it			
After double of a natural notrump call, XX is relay, others system on.			
Redouble never to play; can show values, step, relay, or rescue.			
In step auctions, X or XX show the second worst hand (after P).

2/1 GF, 5542, 1N 15–17, 2N 20–21, weak 2♦, 2♥, 2♠
2♣ strong with 2♦ semi-pos and 2♥ double neg.
4♣/4♦ openings: Namyats in 1 st and 2 nd seat
1N often includes a 5c major
Stayman always invitational or better.
1N forcing (unless passed), hands from 3 to 15 points.
Inverted minor-suit raises
Signals: UDAC + Smith Peters in NT
Leads: standard honours, 2/4 pips (Polish style)
SPECIAL BIDS THAT MAY REQUIRE DEFENSE
Structured reverses: 2M and 2N are F1, others GF
2-way checkback after 1N and 2N rebids
Fourth-suit GF; cheapest is nebulous, J-3N ±15–17
If X 4 th suit: P no stop, XX 1 stop, bid short, NT 2 stop
1N forcing includes 3334 with 13–15 HCP
Double Drury: 2♣ 8–11, 4M; 2♦ 9–11, 3M
Rubensohl after 2-level interference over 1N open or overcall. 2N inv+ in ♠ or any weak; others transfer inv+
In comp. when p. bid 1M, 2N 8+ with 4c support.
Good-Bad 2N: 2N shows weaker hand than 3X
Lebensohl after t/o double at 2-level; J-3N no stopper.
4♣, 4♦ opening: Namyats in 1 st /2 nd , natural in 3 rd /4 th
Multi-Landy over their 1N opening
SPECIAL FORCING PASS SEQUENCES
Pass is forcing below the level of a force.
After a value-based game force or bid, pass is forcing.
