

DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING
OVERCALLS (Style: Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)
1 level = 4+ cards, 2 level =5+, new suit = F1, All direct raises are Courtesy, Jump raises Pre-emptive, 2NT = 4 cards limit+, new suit jumps = weak, Reverse
e.g. (1S) – 2H – (2S) – 2NT = good Heart Raise where 3H is comp
INT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
2 nd = 15/18, X then NT = 19/21, X then jump 2NT = 22/23, system on
4 th = 10/14, X then NT = 15/17, 2NT = 18/19, X then jump = 20/21
All systems on. Escape from INT doubled, all systems on Redouble asks opener to bid 2C plus trf sequences after 2D and 2H. Doubles after interference = T/O, Lebensohl
, Scramble after T/O doubles
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
(1m) – 2m = majors, 2NT = lowest two, jumps in known suit = pre,
New suit after Michaels = nat, NF
Ne Reopen: 4 th = intermediate
DIRECT & JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)
Direct cue = Michaels, (1m) – 2m = majors, 5/5+, (1M) – 2M = OM + minor, 5/5+.
Direct cue = Michaels in 4 th but strong
Jump cues are stopper asking in 2 nd .
VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening;PH)
Over Strong NT – Hamilton in conjunction with Woolsley
Over Weak NT – Hamilton and penalty
VS.PREEMTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)
2 level - 2NT = 16/18 – systems on, cue = stopper ask, 3NT to play, after X – 2NT = Leb in all seats. Strong jumps, Pass then 2NT = minors.
3 level – 3NT = 17+.
VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♣ or 2♣
Against 1♣ double for the majors, 1NT for the minors
Against 2♣ double for the majors, 2NT for the minors
OVER OPPONENTS' TAKEOUT DOUBLE
Jordan 2NT = 4 cards 11+ raise after a major suit opening. Jumps new suit = weak.
